

COMPETITION OBJECTIVES

Popularization among children and young people of workshop graphics, various techniques of flat, concave, and convex printing, which, like painting and drawing techniques, can become an important means of artistic expression for them. The Biennial is an opportunity to exchange experiences between its participants, teachers, and instructors, and the post-competition exhibition will be a review of graphic works of children and young people from various countries.

PARTICIPANTS

We invite children and young people of up to **19** years of age to participate in the competition. The works will be evaluated in five age groups:

up to **7** years, **8-10** years, **11-13** years, **14-16** years, **17-19** years.

FORMAT

The maximum size of a work is 100x70cm.

TECHNIQUES

1. Traditional graphic techniques:

Linocut, woodcut, gypsum engraving, collography, papercut, drypoint, etching, aquatint, lithography, template, serigraphy, and other intaglio, convex, and flat printing techniques.

2. Computer graphics.

The competition will not accept works sent by e-mail, or works made using other artistic techniques, such as drawing or painting.

DATES

The deadline for submitting the works is **31 May, 2023.**

The evaluation of the works by an international jury will take place on 28-30 June, 2023.

The summary of the competition and the opening of the post-competition exhibition will take place on **19 October, 2023.**
